Japanese Minor Program

Students majoring in fields in which a knowledge of Japanese language and culture would improve job opportunities (e.g., International Business, International Law, International Relations, Computer Science, Engineering) should consider earning a minor in Japanese.

Placement Policy: Native and/or bilingual speakers of Japanese may not receive credit for First-Year or Second-Year Japanese. Other students who believe they are qualified to begin at a level higher than Jpn 111 (first term, first year) are encouraged to contact the Japanese Advisor about appropriate placement.

Requirements: (18 hours)

Jpn 311, 312, 313, Third-Year Japanese	9 hrs
Jpn 333, Japanese Culture	3 hrs
Upper-division electives (to be approved by Japanese advisor)	6 hrs

Courses must be completed with a grade of C- or above.
Grading option of S/U is permitted. A minimum of two upper-division courses must be completed at OSU in Corvallis.

You may officially declare a minor at OSU by completing a Declaration of Minor form with the Registrar's Office and with the Department of Foreign Languages & Literatures.
